

# Water Care Instructions for Chlorine-Free BaquaSpa

### **Start-Up Procedures**

- 1. To fill up the spa: Remove one of the filter cartridges and place hose inside of the hole and fill tub to cover the highest set of jets.
- 2. Plug in or turn the power on to start circulating the water. Allow water to heat up to at least 80 degrees before adding any chemicals.
- 3. BaquaSpa Products
  - A. Step 1 Waterline Control: Add 1 oz. per 100 gallons of water
  - B. Step 2 Oxidizer: Add 2 oz. per 100 gallons of water
  - C. Step 3 Add 2oz Spa Shield circulate on high speed for 15 minutes before going on to step 4
  - D. Step 4 Sanitizer: Add 2/3 oz. per 100 gallons of water and circulate on high speed for 15 minutes
- 4. Add 16 oz of Calcium Hardness Increaser. Only add 2 oz every 20 to 30 minutes. Water with appropriate calcium levels foam less, sparkle better and the water is less aggressive towards metals and plastics.
- 5. Wait approximately 24 hours and bring in a water sample to be tested for any chemical adjustments.

# **Appropriate Levels**

Sanitizer: 30-50 ppm

pH: 7.2-7.8

Alkalinity: 80-120ppm

• Calcium Hardness: 200-500

# **Measurement Conversions**

- 1oz = 2 tablespoons
- 4oz = ½ cup
- 8oz = 1 cup
- 1lb = 2 cups

# **Helpful Hints:**

- Always run the spa jets when adding chemicals.
- Leave covers open for 20-30 minutes after adding Oxidizer the impurities need to off-gas
- Wash the area above the waterline with spa water weekly after adding Sanitizer to clean this surface.

## **Weekly Maintenance Procedures:**

- 1. Test water with test strips and adjust levels, as necessary. If you are unsure, bring in 4-6 oz of spa water to Pettis for a computerized water test.
- 2. BaquaSpa Products First Add 1oz Spa Shield then reference the chart below

# Every two weeks:

- Rinse filter cartridges to remove any debris. Inspect for discoloration which means the cartridges need to be chemically cleaned.
- 2. Make sure the water level is up and covering the highest jet. Topping up the water level is a regular occurrence.

# Monthly:

- Chemically clean the filter cartridge(s) with BaquaSpa Filter Cleaner
- 2. Bring in a water sample to Pettis Pools for a computerized water test.

#### Reminders:

- Always leave spa cover open after adding the Oxidizer.
- Always close air-injector knobs when not using the spa.
- Spa water needs to be drained and refilled every 4 months.
- Clean the underside of the spa cover occasionally with bleach water to prevent odors
